This term we will be learning all about me, we will be looking at the similarities and difference between all of us, we will be celebrating what makes us special and discussing all the wonderful things that make up who we are.


Clothing and Shoes:

It is really important that your children bring to school

- Light coat/jacket
- FULL change of clothes (including shoes and nappy sacks for wet clothes) This stays at school unless your child has an accident
- Lunchbox
- Welly boots
- Water bottle
- Puddle suit

Please NAME EVERYTHING as children do loose things.

Children must wear closed toe shoes (trainers, school shoes but NOT flip flops or sandals). Please encourage your child's independence by



sending them in Velcro or slip on shoes and not shoelaces unless they can do these up themselves.

As part of our 'Healthy Schools' status, we ask that there are no chocolate products, sweets, juice, squash or fizzy drinks in the children's lunch boxes. NO NUTS as we are a nut free school, this includes Nutella as children may have allergies.

If you want help with lunchboxes please ask and we will happily help.

Speech Therapist

This year we are lucky enough to have a senior speech therapist in school 1 morning a week. Tiffany will be supporting Nursery with speech and language and children's communication skills. Throughout the year she will be available to talk to parents and she will make herself available if she needs to speak to you.

Illness

If your child is sick (vomiting or diarrhoea) they can not come back to school until 48 hours after the last episode.

If your child has a high temperature please do not send them into school.
