Temporary change in drop off and collection arrangements for Nursery and Reception pupils

Procedure for Nursery parents / carers

Nursery parents and carers should therefore use the side door (adjacent to the school main entrance pathway) to drop and collect their children from Nursery.

Procedure for Reception parents / carers

As the pathway leading to our Reception classes will also be out of use, parents / carers may use the main school entrance for drop off if this is more convenient. Parents / carers using the main school entrance should walk through the school hall and enter the Reception classrooms via the fire exit at the back of the hall. They will leave through the Reception internal doors.

However, as the school entrance is very busy at the end of the school day; to avoid congestion, Reception pupils must still be collected from the exterior classroom doors. Parents / carers will therefore need to walk all the way around the exterior of the school building at home time.
