Clothing

A Plat Douet navy blue polo shirt will need to be purchased from JSSK and worn in Nursery. This can be paired with jeans, trousers, skirts, shorts etc of your choice. Please bear in mind that the children will be playing outdoors in all weathers and be involved in messy activities, so best clothes are not appropriate.

Your child also needs a named coat on a daily basis, suitable footwear for outdoor play and a sunhat during the summer. Footwear will need to allow the children to run, climb and move safely (no open-toe shoes).

Please do not allow your child to wear jewellery to nursery, as this can be dangerous. ALL ITEMS MUST BE NAMED.

<u>Curriculum</u>

Your child will follow the 'Development Matters in the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum' which is split in to seven areas of learning:- Physical Development, Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Communication and Language, Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding of the World and Expressive Arts and Design.

You will receive a curriculum overview each term. It will outline the curriculum areas to be covered in that term.

Each week the Nursery staff write up the learning and activities that will be covered during that week on a Parent Information Board that is displayed in the cloakroom area in Nursery. The weekly snack list is also displayed here.

Toilet Training

Before your child starts in nursery he/she must be toilet trained and capable of using the toilet without the help of an adult. It will help your child if their clothes were easy for them to remove and fasten again and do not require belts. If your child has an accident we do not get upset or make a fuss. Accidents do happen! So we would ask for your child to have a spare change of clothes (pants/trousers/socks and shoes) in a named bag that can remain on their peg...just in case!

<u>Illness</u>

If your child is not well, on any medication, or suffering from something that may be passed on to an another child, please keep him/her at home and let us know as soon as possible by telephoning the school office.

Inhalers for asthmatic conditions must be placed in the care of the nursery staff.

It is important that you keep us up to date with at least two emergency contact telephone numbers.

School Registration

Parents must fill out a separate registration form for a possible entry to Plat Douet School.

Please ensure your child is registered at their catchment school as admission to Nursery does not automatically ensure a place in school.
