Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
<b><u>Aim</u>:</b> Targeted pupils make accelerated progress in Speaking and Listening <b><u>Activity</u>:</b> Additional teacher in the Foundation Stage with a focus on quality speaking and listening. Key strategies used will be: storytelling, providing a running commentary, recount, developing language displays, vocabulary/modelling language structures.	Pupils will make expected progress + in communication and language, listening and attention, understanding, and speaking. Pupils identified with Speech and Language needs will have focused support and will meet expectations / make significant progress. Pupils identified by Speech and Language will conclude their interventions and no longer need specific intervention.
Project and Rationale <u>Aim:</u> Plan for groups of pupils particularly those pupils who were most impacted by the school closures in 2020 and as identified by school data <u>Activity:</u> Small group support (Pre/Post Teach, BR@P, Precision teaching, Reading Response)	<b>Expected Outcome</b> All pupils will make at least expected progress with some making greater than expected. Those not making expected progress will be identified and targeted for support.
Project and Rationale <u>Aim:</u> Parents develop their knowledge & understanding of supporting their children's learning at home. <u>Activity:</u>	<b>Expected Outcome</b> Pupils will make expected progress + in communication and language, listening and attention, understanding, and speaking.

IMPACT Groups of 4 parents accompanied by their children observe the teacher using resources to promote communication and language at home. Specific focus on storytelling and extending vocabulary. Parents will attend 3 sessions. <b>REAL</b> All nursery parents and their children (in groups of 8) will be invited to at least one event per term, led by the Nursery team. In the spring term, 3 parents will be visited in their home environment to lead a series of activities linked to maths. In the summer and autumn terms, 3 cohorts of 3 parents will be visited in their home environment and the Nursery team to lead a series of activities including mark making, books, speaking and print in the environment.	Pupils will have had the opportunity to be immersed in rich literacy experiences to support language development and low literacy starting points. Parents will be able to support their children at home with their learning.
Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
<ul> <li>Aim: To help enable pupils reach their full potential in English through high quality teaching.</li> <li>Activity: Writing Project This strategy is based on pupils, with poor oral language skills, being given enriching out of school experiences to motivate them to write.</li> </ul>	Each cohort participating in the 'Writing Project' will make a minimum 4 months accelerated progress over the 15 weeks.
